The American AgCredit Scholarship is now being administered through the Plumas-Sierra Cattlemen's Association. INSTRUCTIONS: Application must be completed by the applicant, and postmarked by, or delivered to, the address above, by **April 25, 2019**, to be considered by the Scholarship Committee. This scholarship is awarded to students graduating from a Plumas or Sierra County High School, pursuing an agriculture or agri-business career. Students must plan to attend an accredited college or university and major in agriculture, agribusiness, business, accounting, finance, or another agriculturally related field. The minimum GPA requirement to be considered for this scholarship is 3.0. Recipients will be selected based on leadership skills, a demonstrated commitment to the industry, grades, and financial need. Applicant interviews may be required upon request.
